

① Click on "Timetable" and then click on "Oral Timetable".



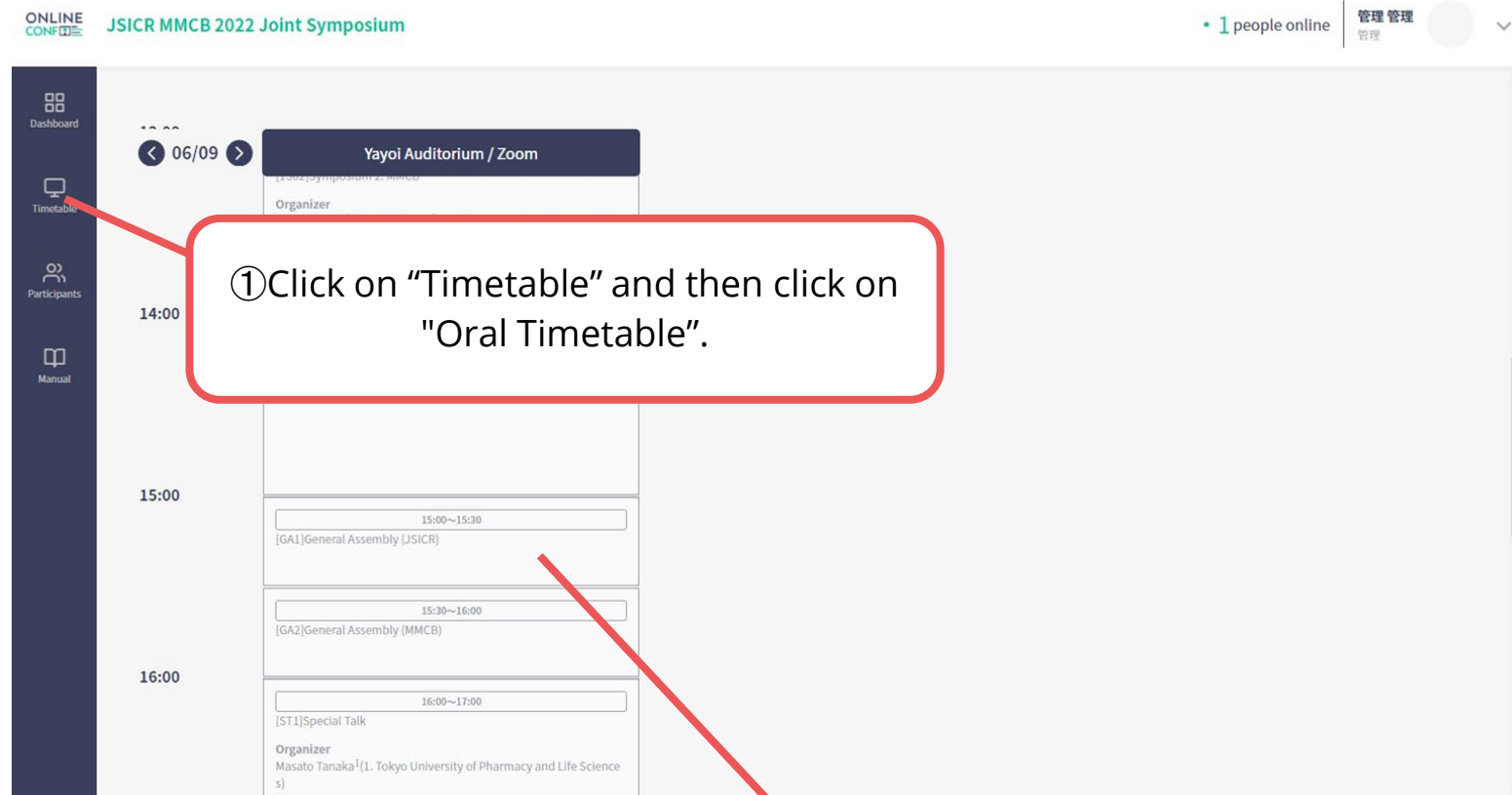

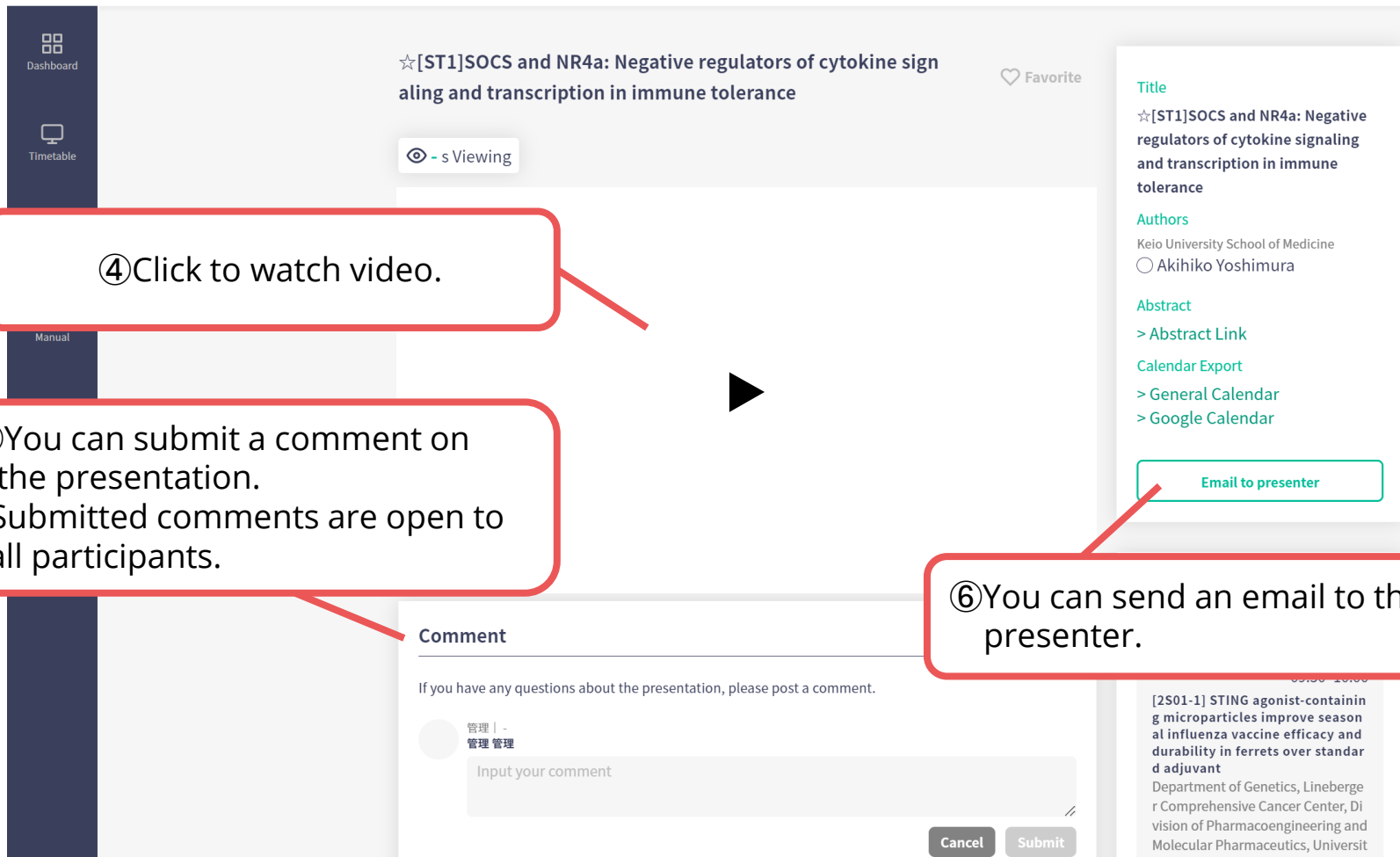
