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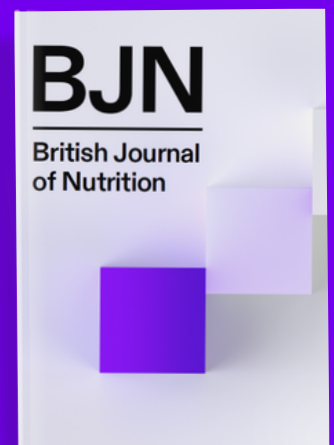

### **Professor John Mathers, Editor-in-Chief, *British Journal of Nutrition***

John Mathers is Professor of Human Nutrition in Newcastle University, UK. He undertook research and training towards the PhD degree in University of Cambridge, UK, and carried out post-doctoral research in both the University of Cambridge and University of Edinburgh, UK. His major research interests are in understanding how eating patterns influence risk of age-related diseases including diabetes, dementia and cancer. Among his external roles, John was President of the Nutrition Society (2001 – 2004) and serves/ served on several UK and international grants panels and/or research strategy boards. He is Chair of the Board of Trustees of the British Nutrition Foundation and a Trustee of the Rank Prize Funds.

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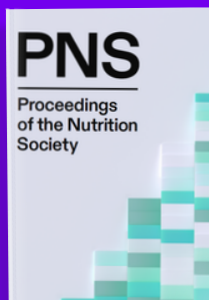
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
